SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Two types of scholarships are available through the Denver Chapter of IFMA. Scholarships are available to members of the Denver IFMA Chapter of IFMA who do not receive employer funding for ongoing educational events sponsored by the Chapter. Members who are currently unemployed or experiencing other financial hardships can also apply for these scholarships. The second category of scholarships is for full-time college/university students in Colorado who are enrolled in a designated major that complements the many aspects involved in the facilities management profession. The scholarships are awarded during a fall or spring school semester.
