More than 60% of those who are homeless in Colorado are families with children. Your support helps the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless provide health care and housing services for these children and their families.

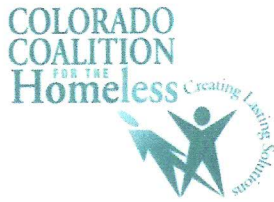

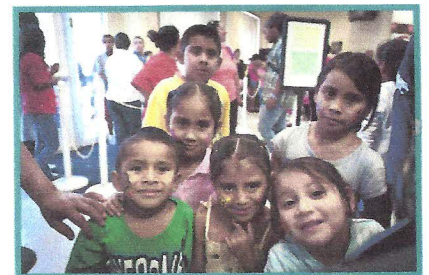


## The 2011 Back to School Healthy Kids Fair was a huge success!
