At the start of his new position, Darin identified pre-existing hail damage, which the City could claim on their insurance policy for a claim of over \$500,000. He reinvested the funds on capital infrastructure work, which included replacement of 24 individual Roof Top Units (RTU's), a new PVC roof with an extended 25-year warranty, significant parking lot paving repairs and specialty walkway/deck repairs, with funds remaining to accomplish a tenant improvement project in 2017.
