Energize Denver Ordinance Updates

The City of Denver has released some important updates on the new benchmarking ordinance, Energize Denver. This ordinance affects all commercial and multi-family buildings greater than 25,000 square feet by requiring these buildings to benchmark and report energy use using ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager.

The Energize Denver website has been updated with important details addressing:

- Who needs to comply with the new ordinance
