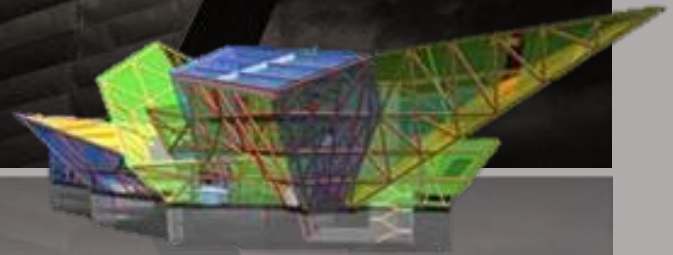
**Essentials of FM Class \$800 10 module/3 days Bundled for \$800**
