From feasibility and planning to operations and maintenance, the tremendously complex nature of capital projects generates an enormous amount of data throughout all phases of the facility lifecycle. Making the right strategic asset decisions often means ensuring all stakeholders are properly coordinated and have the right information at the right time. This is particularly crucial during facilities operations and asset management – which can typically represent between 75-85% of the Owner's total financial investment. However, many organizations lack good data governance for facilities information. Data governance outlines a level of integrity and quality control to the process of creating, managing, and using an organization's data.

An American economic and social theorist, writer, public speaker, political advisor, and activist, Rifkin's most recent work is [The Zero Marginal Cost Society: The Internet of Things, the Collaborative Commons, and the Eclipse of Capitalism](#).

Published in 2014, in this book Rifkin;

- hypothesizes the impact the Internet of Things will have on society and the economy,
- re-frames the case for moving off nuclear/fossil fuels to renewable energy, indicating the energy infrastructure is facing \$100-Trillion dollars in stranded assets,
- and the plummeting of marginal costs is spawning a hybrid economy part capitalist market and part Collaborative Commons with far reaching implications for society.

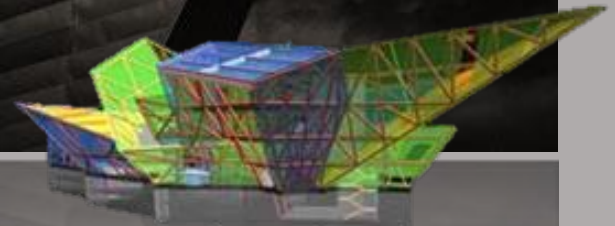
